Donna Jones, of Exeter, has donated \$50,000 towards the community project to construct a new pedestrian bridge along Morrison Line, on the South Huron Trail. The bridge is to be called Jones Bridge and it is dedicated by Donna Jones, in loving memory of Ted Jones.

Donna's generous donation serves as a lasting and fitting tribute to her husband. Ted gave the gift of conservation and nature enjoyment to others during his lifetime and Donna is continuing Ted's legacy with her gift. This donation will make it possible for thousands of people to enjoy nature more safely on this multi-use trail. This is such an extremely appropriate way to remember a man who touched so many lives.

Why this site was selected

A location downstream of Morrison Dam was selected after consideration of all options. The vehicle bridge on Morrison Line cannot support a pedestrian sidewalk beside it and it would not be possible to maintain a sidewalk in winter.

After discussion with community members, staff, and experts in the field, it was agreed the proposed location would be cost-effective and would provide trail users with a safer, more scenic alternative to walking beside traffic on Morrison Line.


