Have a Safe Visit

CAUTION: These are recreational nature trails for hiking. Surfaces may be slippery or uneven.

- Wear appropriate clothing, footwear and equipment for your trail activity.
- Be careful near the water.
- Watch for Poison Ivy and ticks.

Open sunrise to sunset daily

Rules

These rules protect you and others. They are enforced by *Conservation Authorities Act* and *Trespass to Property Act*.

- Motorized vehicles, bicycles, horses, hunting, alcohol use, drone use, fires and camping are *not* permitted.
- Keep dogs on a leash and under control always and clean up after dog.
- Do not remove or damage plants, trees, wildlife, signs or structures.
- Stay on the trails and respect neighbouring landowners.
- Fishing is permitted following all applicable provincial laws.
- Do not litter. Put waste in provided container or take it home with you.
- Smoking permitted following all applicable provincial laws.

About the Park

- In 1973, Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority purchased the land for this 19.6-hectare (48.5-acre) park to protect an area for walking.
- This park is within the Carolinian Life Zone and has Oak Savanna, and sand dunes with the Ausable River as a border on one side.
- Take an hour to hike the (difficult) two-kilometre loop through forests, dunes and riverside.
- Either of two connector trails will reduce the length of time and difficulty level to complete a loop.
- A shorter accessible trail from the parking lot leads to a viewing platform to look at the Ausable River Cut.

Recreational Trail Description

Accessible Trail

- **Distance:** 535 metres.
- **Surface:** Stone dust.
- **Width:** Two metres.
- **Difficulty:** Easy; level.

Dune Trail

- **Distance:** Two kilometres.
- **Surface:** Dirt.
- **Width:** One metre.
- **Difficulty:** Difficult.
- **Elevation gains:** 20 metres.
