Have a Safe Visit

- Stay on designated trails
 - Use caution. Trails are natural and may be uneven and slippery
 - Prepare for how the weather may affect your visit
 - Trails are not maintained in the winter
 - Do not feed wildlife
 - Property is open from sunrise to sunset
 - **Caution:** There is Poison Ivy on the property. To minimize potential exposure, stay on designated trails and ensure your pet is on a leash and under control
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About the Park

- The former Ausable River Conservation Authority purchased the 3.2 hectares (8 acres) of land that is now the Lucan Conservation Area, in 1961, to protect the Little Ausable River and provide an area for passive recreation including hiking and fishing.
 - Enjoy the spring wildflowers, tall trees, and beautiful autumn colours.
 - The single-track dirt trail takes about 20 minutes to complete and has something new every season.

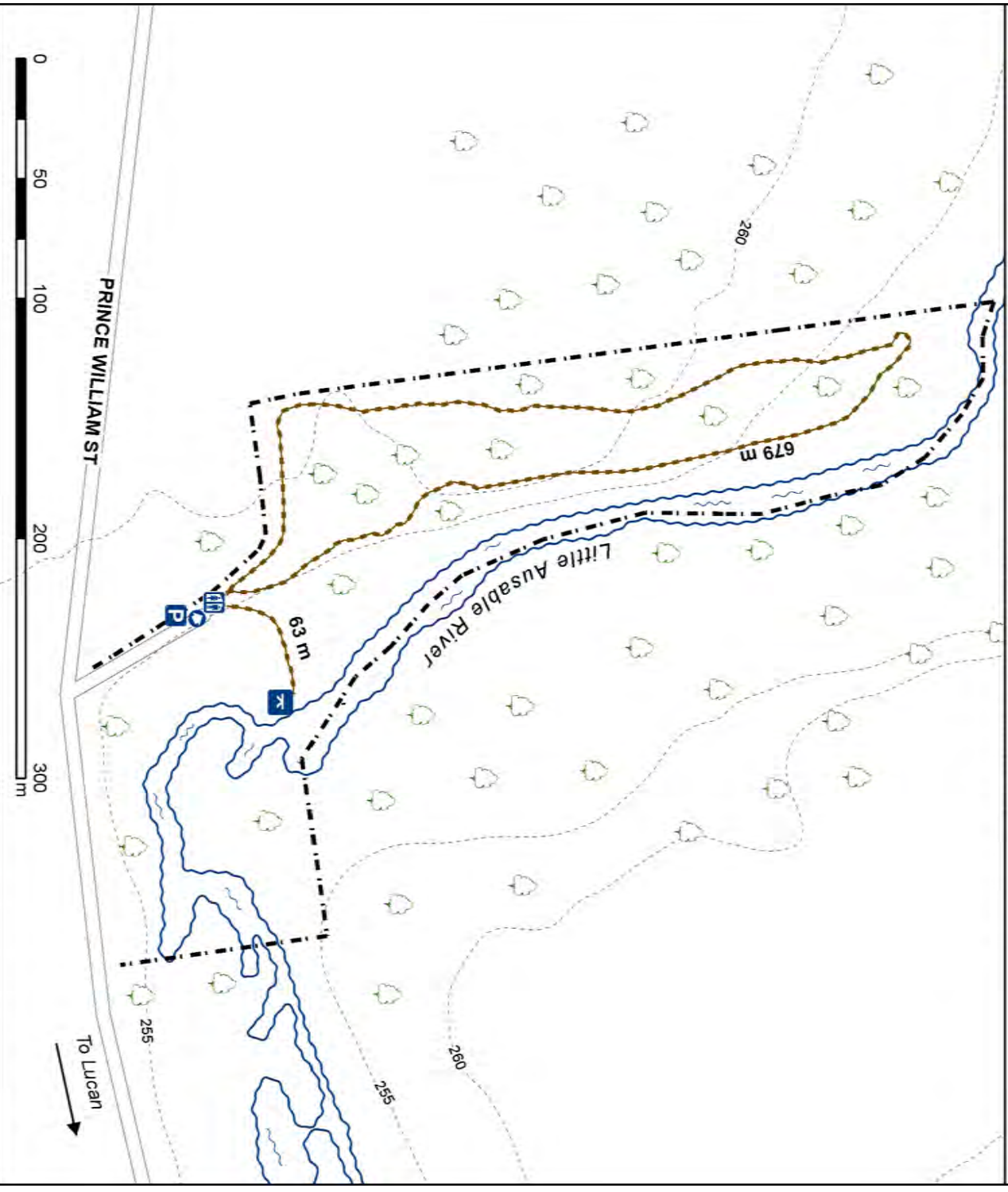
Recreational Trail Description

- **Distance:** About 1 km (0.6 mile)
 - **Difficulty:** Easy. Gently rolling terrain.
 - **Elevation gains:** 5 metres (16 feet)
 - **Trail Width:** 1.25 metres (4 feet)
 - **Trail Surface:** Packed earth; dirt.
 - Trail and picnic area subject to flooding. Use caution and avoid trails if water covered.
